Adval Tech was the target of a cyber-attack on the night to March 2, 2025. The IT systems of the Adval Tech Group were immediately shut down globally, and necessary measures were taken to protect the IT infrastructure.

Niederwangen, March 3, 2025, 7.00 a.m.– On March 2, 2025, a cyber-attack was carried out against the IT systems of the Adval Tech Group worldwide. In response, all IT systems of the Group were promptly shut down according to the emergency plan. As a result, production interruptions may occur at various locations.

The Adval Tech Group is working closely with internal and external cybersecurity experts and the relevant authorities to restore business operations as quickly as possible.
